### **SETTINGS**

**BEARS' HOME:** A comfy chair for Mama; beanbag chair or a big pillow on the floor for Baby; and a large hard wooden chair for Papa.

**COFFEE SHOP:** A café table and two chairs.

**RESTAURANT:** A booth or a table with chairs.

**FAIRY TALE WOOD AND PARK:** A forest background.

### Scene 1

*(AT RISE: The home of the three bears. MAMA BEAR sits in a comfy chair scrolling through her phone idly. BABY BEAR sits nearby in a beanbag chair on the floor or a big pillow, also on a device. There is also a large hard wooden chair for PAPA BEAR who enters, holding some mail.)*

**PAPA:** Mail's here.

**MAMA:** *(Kind of sitting up.)* Anything good?

**PAPA:** Bills. More bills. Things for a sale at the Honey Shop.  
That's it.

**MAMA:** *(Hesitantly.)* Nothing ... from her?

**PAPA:** You have to stop asking.

**MAMA:** I'm just—

**PAPA:** You're curious. I know.

**MAMA:** I just feel so bad about how we scared her off.

**PAPA:** I know.

**BABY:** I roared so loud!

**MAMA:** You did.

**BABY:** Because she was sleeping in my bed!

**PAPA:** Yup.

**BABY:** And I was already mad because she broke my chair.

**PAPA:** That surprised me. She didn't look that heavy.

**MAMA:** Well. *(SHE shrugs.)* Ikea.

**PAPA:** Fair enough. But Mama...all things considered that girl's not coming back any time soon. It's been weeks. And we scared her off.

**MAMA:** I know. I just wish we had a second chance. We're nice bears.

**PAPA:** We are.

**BABY:** I'm vicious!

**PAPA:** Of course you are.

*(THEY growl playfully at each other.)*

**MAMA:** Do you think anyone else in Fairy-Tale Wood might have seen her?

**PAPA:** No one's ever mentioned it. But I've never really asked.

**BABY:** If she comes back, she can't break my beanbag!

**MAMA:** That's why we got it, dear. *(To PAPA.)* Maybe after our house, she went to someone else's.

**PAPA:** Because she wasn't done breaking furniture and stealing porridge?

**MAMA:** Maybe?

**PAPA:** That seems weird.

**MAMA:** Well, we did interrupt her nap.

**BABY:** In my bed!

**MAMA:** Maybe she was still tired, the poor thing,

**PAPA:** That's a whole lot of maybe, Mama. Look, it was strange, it happened, we scared her off, and it's over. A silly human came into Fairy Tale Wood, poked around, and got caught. We lost a batch of porridge and a chair.

**BABY:** My chair!

**PAPA:** It probably could have been worse.

**MAMA:** I know. I just wish we could tell her that we're sorry for scaring her.

**BABY:** I'm not!

**MAMA:** *(Sadly.)* We're nice bears.

*(LIGHTS fade.)*

**Scene 2**

*(LIGHTS up on a cafe. MAMA BEAR and LUCY GOOSEY are at a table having coffee.)*

**MAMA:** And like I said to Papa, we're nice bears.

**LUCY:** I've always thought so!

**MAMA:** Thank you, Lucy. I'm just not sure what to do. Papa says to forget about it, but I just can't.

**LUCY:** Well, it must have been very scary, finding someone in your house!
