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SYNOPSIS

Everyone agrees: Prince Harris is the world's worst prince! ("A Prince That's the Worst") It's obvious he thinks only about himself. ("Me, Myself, and I") He finally faces a huge consequence after hunting in the off-limits Magic Wood. Fairy Queen Mab turns him into a frog, and he needs a kiss from a princess to break the spell. But that's not so easy with Princess Jillian, a headstrong basketball whiz. She seeks an independent life and cares deeply about the environment. ("Work It Out") Can both overcome their differences to find their own "Happily Ever After"? The classic Grimm Brothers folktale is contemporary in references and in the music. Running time: 60 minutes.

AUTHOR'S NOTE

The show is intended to be anachronistic, combining a medieval fairy tale with contemporary references in the script and the music. Think of it as a comic book version of the story. The idea is to have audience members feel familiarity in the fantasy.

Feel free to dial up the medieval nature or contemporary nature of the piece as you see fit. In the event Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and Justin Bieber become outdated, feel free to change those references.

DEER: Deer of Magic Wood. Can be chorus or single actor. **RABBITS:** Rabbits of Magic Wood. Can be chorus or single actor.

BIRDS: Birds of Magic Wood. Can be chorus or single actor.

FIREBIRD: A phoenix.

SNAKE: A snake from the Magic Wood. **BADGER:** A badger from the Magic Wood.

FOX: A fox from the Magic Wood.

PRINCESS JILLIAN: King Lentor's only daughter. Loves

basketball.

SAKINA: Friend of Princess Jillian. **LING:** Friend of Princess Jillian. **KING LENTOR:** King of Johoria.

PRINCE OF SLUMBERLAND: Crown Prince of the

Slumberland Nation.

COMMENTATOR: Basketball game commentator. Could be

played by an actor or voiceover.

SAVAGE: Opposing basketball team member. **HUNTRA:** Opposing basketball team member. **PRINCE HARRIS' SERVANTS:** Chorus.

KINGDOM FOLK: Chorus

(AT RISE: A castle in the kingdom of Sentralia. Enter all the COMMON FOLK of the kingdom. Chorus lines can be divided up as desired.)

ARE YOU READY FOR A STORY, SET IN A FAIRY-TALE WORLD? THE PRINCE IS HANDSOME AND JOLLY. THE DREAM OF EV'RY GIRL. HE'LL MEET A FEMININE PRINCESS, TO RESCUE BY THE END OF THE TALE. THEN GET YOURSELF READY FOR THE LARGEST EPIC FAIL!

HENRY: The prince is coming! Everyone, look busy!

(All the SERVANTS scramble to look busy cleaning the castle. Enter PRINCE HARRIS.)

SONG #2 ME, MYSELF, AND I

PRINCE HARRIS:

MAYBE THERE ARE THOSE WHO THINK THAT I HAVE NO REGARD FOR OTHER PEOPLE. BUT I'M HERE TO TELL YOU, THAT'S SIMPLY NOT TRUE. THERE ARE THOSE I CONSIDER MY EQUAL. I'M TALKING 'BOUT

ME, MYSELF, AND I.
ARE THE ONLY ONES THAT QUALIFY.
THEY MAKE THE BEST OF FRIENDS,
ON WHOM I CAN DEPEND.
ME, MYSELF, AND I, I, I, I, I, I,
I, I, I, I, I, I, I, I, I.

THOUGH I AM SURROUNDED BY SERVANTS ALL DAY LONG, THAT CATER TO WHAT I SAY. I STILL FEEL ALONE BECAUSE I'M NOT SHOWN ANY LOVE IN A MEANINGFUL WAY. BUT I HAVE

I TRIED MAKING FRIENDS WITH OTHER ROYALS, BUT SOMEHOW IT'S ALL IN VAIN. 'CAUSE THEY KEEP SAYING STUFF LIKE: "YOU'RE A JERK!" "YOU'RE ANNOYING!" "STOP PULLING MY HAIR!" OR "WHY ARE YOU SUCH A PAIN?"

(RAP SECTION.)
HAVE YOU SEEN A FACE THAT'S QUITE LIKE THIS?
BETTER TAKE A PHOTO NOW OR YOU'RE GOING TO MISS
IT.

PRINCE HARRIS: (Cont'd.)

I'M THE PRINCE OF THE KINGDOM I AM RIGHT ON TOP. EVERYONE SAYS "YES." NO ONE EVER SAYS "STOP." DON'T YOU KNOW IT'S ALL ABOUT ME? I DEMAND ABSOLUTE LOYALTY. WHEN I GO OUT PEOPLE SCRAPE AND BOW. DON'T LOOK ME IN THE EYE 'CAUSE I'M A SACRED COW. TODAY'S MY BIRTHDAY GONNA SHOUT IT FROM THE STEEPLE. 'CAUSE HUMILITY IS JUST FOR COMMON PEOPLE.

PRINCE HARRIS: (Cont'd. Spoken.) Hello!? Where are my backup dancers?????

(The SERVANTS rush into place as backup dancers for PRINCE HARRIS and dance the "Spoilt Prince Jig" which really looks like any dance number with Justin Bieber in it.)

PRINCE HARRIS: (Cont'd.)

PRINCE HARRIS: (Cont'd.) Three of you! Massage me! (Three SERVANTS massage him.) You, over there! Dance for me. (SERVANT dances according to his demands.) Faster! Faster! Now do it like a gorilla! Faster! Alright go away! You're terrible! THE REST OF YOU TOO! (The SERVANTS scuttle off.) Except you, Henry.

(HENRY freezes mid-step, makes a face to the audience, and returns smilingly to the PRINCE.)

HENRY: Yes, my lord?

PRINCE HARRIS: What is the status of the bouncy castle? I want it to be larger than the Prince of Slumberland's.

HENRY: Inflating as we speak, sire.

PRINCE HARRIS: What about my birthday cake? It needs to be as tall as a Christmas tree.

HENRY: Installation is complete.

PRINCE HARRIS: Oh, and uninvite the Prince of Slumberland. He didn't wish me happy birthday on Facebook. And everyone knows you have to wish someone happy birthday on Facebook. If not, you're not really friends.

HENRY: Uh, my lord... that might cause a war with Slumberland.

PRINCE HARRIS: I don't care. Are there enough trees for the bonfire?

HENRY: We're running a little low, your highness...

PRINCE HARRIS: Then cut some more! The Magic Wood is large. It won't miss a few trees.

HENRY: But, sire...if we cut down more trees, it will severely impact the weather systems in our country. Already we are seeing an increase in national temperatures.

PRINCE HARRIS: I don't care. Just do it. And prepare the horses. I'm going hunting in the Magic Wood.

HENRY: But, sire! It is forbidden to hunt there. Your family made a promise to Queen Mab never to hunt in the Magic Wood.

PRINCE HARRIS: That was years ago. I'm sure she's forgotten about it already. Plus, it's my birthday. And for my birthday I want to hunt the magical firebird. No other prince has ever caught one and I want to be the first.

HENRY: Not to question your judgment, Your Highness, but is that really a good idea? There are consequences to hunting magical creatures.

PRINCE HARRIS: Consequences? That's only something that happens to other people. Now get the horses ready or I'll have your family thrown in jail or something.

HENRY: Yes, my lord! Right away!

(HENRY scuttles off to prepare for the hunt. LIGHTS down.)

Scene 2

(AT RISE: The Magic Wood. Enter QUEEN MAB who calls together a conference of the animals.)

SONG #3 COME TO ME

QUEEN MAB:

COME TO ME CREATURES
HEED MY CALL.
COME TO ME CREATURES
BIG AND SMALL.
COME TO ME CREATURES
MAKE YOURSELF SEEN.
HEED THE CALL, THE CALL OF YOUR QUEEN.

COME ALL THOSE IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD.
MEET IN THE MAGIC WOOD.
COME TO SEE WHAT MUST BE DONE.
BEFORE THE SETTING OF THE SUN.

(Enter the ANIMALS, which may be actors, or actors with puppets.)

ANIMAL CHORUS:

AH! AH! AH! AH! AH!
WE ARE HERE QUEEN.
WE'RE HEEDING YOUR CALL.
WE ARE HERE QUEEN.
BIG AND SMALL.
PREDATOR OR PREY.
SHINY OR DRAB.
WE HEED THE CALL OF QUEEN MAB.
